# **Powder Strokes Brows**

is a technique that involves a combination of Microblading and ombré Brow Shading. Together, this technique creates a fuller makeup look and more dense looking brow. Microblading strokes are places at the beginning of the brow with shading filling the remainder of the brow for a more powdered effect. This technique uses a combination of manual powered and machine tools and is good for all skin types.

## **Pixel Brows**

is a technique that gives a filled in powder effect. This is a great option for those who don't want to wear makeup but want the makeup look. Also good for people with very oily skin, thin skin or those who microblading does not heal well. Ombre/Powdered brows are done with a machine and are not done with a microblading tool. This technique can also be used to make colour corrections or camouflage old permanent makeup and is good for all skin types.

# Phiremoval, what is that?

The PhiRemoval process uses a Glycolic Acid-based solution that immediately begins to penetrate the skin once applied. This motion assists the solution in pulling the ink up to the surface of the epidermis. The technician may make up to 6 passes on the treated area before a Neutralizing solution will be applied to stop the reaction of the Glycolic Acid. This entire process of applying the initial solution and ending with the Neutralizer will take up to 30-40 minutes and the client will be numbed the entire time.

#### Aftercare

In the first two days following the treatment the treated area should be wiped 3-5 times a day with a damp cotton pad and non-abrasive soap. (Johnsons baby soap)

The client is doing this to remove the lymph and allowing the scab to form properly. A skin balm will be given to the client that will aid in the healing and protecting of the area. The client will need to avoid excessively sweating, saunas, direct sunlight or tanning beds, and pools for the next 7 days. No facial or body treatments can be performed on the area for 3-6 weeks after the PhiRemoval procedure.

## **Healing and What to Expect**

The treated area may be sensitive to the touch for a day or two after the treatment. Scabbing is expected to form over the next few days that will contain even more unwanted ink. A secondary scab will most likely occur and it too will have pulled more ink out of the treated area.

\*\*It is important to note that all scabs should fall off naturally and not be picked due to the risk of scarring and hypopigmentation of the skin.

## How many treatments will I need?

The majority of clients who have permanent makeup removed from a facial area (eyebrow, eyeliner, lipliner) have great results and usually, only need one to two treatments.

# Microneedling

is a very efficient and minimally invasive treatment used to rejuvenate the skin of the face and body. The procedure is aimed at stimulating microcirculation and the natural processes of collagen production and regeneration.

The primary appeal of Microneedling is its ability to stimulate the growth of collagen and elastin. Which is the key to new, youthful-looking skin. Topical products applied directly after Microneedling can be absorbed to a far deeper level in the skin, making them more effective.
